RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL HOUSE POLICY

MTC Staff demonstrate this commitment to responsible service through the implementation of the following House Policy:-

All staff who directly work in the sale and or supply of alcohol will hold an RSA certificate approved by the NSW Office of Liquor, Gaming and Racing.

- o The MTC will educate our customers on our duty of care via signage and other communications.
- o The MTC will maintain an incident log for all RSA matters.
- o An RSA register of accredited staff is maintained on-site and will be made available to the appropriate authorities upon request.
- o To assist with the prevention of underage drinking all staff may request valid ID from persons whom they believe may be underage.
- o Persons deemed to be intoxicated will not be granted access to the venue.
- o Intoxicated persons will be refused service and may be removed from the venue.
- o The MTC will work closely with the NSW Police and Licensing Police to develop event related RSA strategies and to monitor the behaviour of customers.
- o When alcohol is available for consumption, food will also be made available.
- o When alcohol is being served free tap water is also available.
- o The MTC will offer non alcoholic and low alcoholic beverages as part of its beverage menus.
- o The MTC will only permit the sale of a maximum of four (4) alcoholic beverages per person, per transaction.
- o The MTC will not serve a person that we know to be stacking drinks.
