Did you know?

The MTC races 24 times each year the most of any NSW Country Race Club.

TAB turnover = \$20 million
(money bet on Wagga races on NSW TAB)

Bookmaker turnover = \$2.5million
(money bet on Wagga races with bookies)

\$150,000 raised for charity each year from racedays and functions at MTC

More than 250 group certificates are issued each year - this does not include TAB, bookmakers, racing industry participants (such as jockeys, trainers etc)

The MTC has approx 40-50 non-racing functions per year including weddings, conferences, parties (no 18th or 21sts)
